This Weekend's Match-up

The Raiders earned a split last weekend when they hosted last-place Vermont and No. 5 Dartmouth, as they defeated the Catamounts 5-0 and fell to the Big Green 4-1. Colgate travels to the North Country to try to widen its lead over 8th-place Yale and chase next weekend's opponent, Cornell. The Saints hold a one-game edge on the Raiders in the series history between the two teams, with an 8-0 victory on November 13, 1999 in Canton.

This weekend will also mark a homecoming for two of Colgate's coaches: assistant coach Scott Wiley is a 1993 St. Lawrence grad, and head coach Ted Wisner grew up in nearby Potsdam.

Head Coach Ted Wisner

Colgate head coach Ted Wisner is in his third year at the helm of the women's ice hockey team. The 2000 ACHA Division III national coach of the year, Wisner holds a 47-26-5 record entering this weekend's series.

Special Teams

The Raiders will be hard pressed to improve its already impressive 89.6% penalty kill as they face a St. Lawrence power-play that has been 25.9% effective in league play. Colgate will also likely find it difficult to improve its 14.6% power-play in the face of the Saints' 90.7% league penalty kill.

The Goalie Report

After putting in two admirable performances last weekend, it looks like freshman Rebecca Lahar has distinguished herself as the Raiders' top goaltender heading into the homestretch. Lahar has now played 52% of the team's total minutes, and holds a .900 save percentage.

Raiders' Rookie Rocket

With her hat-trick against the Catamounts, freshman Cheryl Setchell moved into a tie for second place among rookie scorers in the league. With just four games left in the regular season, however, Setchell is very unlikely to catch the player who holds first place, Harvard's Nicole Corriero, who has a 20-point edge on the Colgate rookie.

What Can't She Do?

Not only did freshman starting goaltender Rebecca Lahar earn her third shutout of the season against Vermont, add 56 saves to her season total on the weekend, and establish herself as the team's top netminder, she also picked up her first two career penalties in Saturday's 4-1 loss to the Big Green. Lahar was whistled for interference late in the second period, and for tripping with seconds to go in the third.

Six Shorties and Counting

With six short-handed goals this season, the Raiders have broken the team mark for most man-down tallies in one year. At the same time, Colgate has not allowed any short-handed scores this year. Freshman Cheryl Setchell's third goal on Friday, which was her second short-handed goal this season, caused her to tie Colgate's single-season record for short-handed goals by one player.

Top of the Charts

Colgate's line of freshmen Cheryl Setchell, Amanda Barre, and Kristin Cirbus has been a permanent fixture at the top of the Raiders' line chart this season, and it is now fixed at the top of their scoring chart as well. Setchell ranks first with 28 points, Cirbus is second with 23, and Barre ranks third with 15.

Clawing Their Way Up

With their 5-0 shutout win over Vermont last Friday, the Raiders moved into seventh place in the league standings, their highest ranking of the season. To get there, Colgate bumped Yale, who it has a loss and a tie to this season, into eighth place, and the Raiders hold a one-point edge over the Bulldogs.

Top vs. Bottom

The distinct stratification in the ECAC-North is highlighted by the most recent national polls. The top five teams in the league - Dartmouth, Brown, St. Lawrence, Harvard, and Princeton - are all ranked in the top 10 in both national polls this week. These five teams are separated by a mere four points. However, there is a five point gap between fifth and sixth place in the league, and another five point gap between sixth and seventh place.

COLGATE WOMEN'S HOCKEY SHUTS OUT VERMONT, 5-0

HAMILTON, N.Y. – Freshman leading scorer Cheryl Setchell (Sydney, N.S.) had a hat-trick in Friday night's game, as Colgate vanquished Vermont, 5-0.

The first goal of the game came at 5:53 in the first period when Setchell snuck the puck in between Vermont goaltender Tiffany Hayes' skates. Freshmen Kristin Cirbus (Jamestown, N.Y.) and Amanda Barre (Grafton, Ont.) had the assists.

Barre scored the second goal at 13:46 of the same period, with senior Heather Smith (Lake Bluff, Ill.) tallying the assist.

Setchell scored her second goal at 12:38 in the second period and Cirbus and Barre added the helpers.

Setchell's third goal, a short-handed tally, came at 15:24 in the third period, as she won the face-off, streaked down the ice, and deked the goalie to stuff the puck in the left hand corner over the netminder's shoulder.

Rookie Maura Kehoe (Chelsea, Que.) and sophomore Caitlin Hornyak (North Andover, Mass.) set up the final goal of the game, which was scored at 16:34 of the third period by senior Heather Murphy (St. Paul, Minn.).

Raider rookie netminder Rebecca Lahar (Vienna, Va.) had five saves for the night, while Vermont's Hayes had 39.

RAIDERS FALL 4-1 TO DARTMOUTH

HAMILTON, N.Y. – Dartmouth wing Carly Haggard scored two goals to keep the Big Green ahead of Colgate 4-1 Saturday afternoon in Starr Rink.

Haggard scored the first goal of the game at 9:22 as Sarah Clark tallied the assist. Clark picked up the next goal at 10:11 of the second when she hit a rebound into the five hole of Colgate goaltender Rebecca Lahar (Vienna, Va.).
